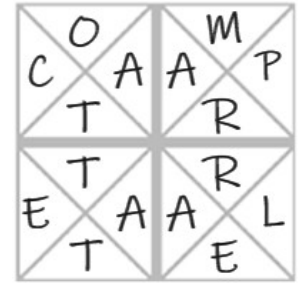


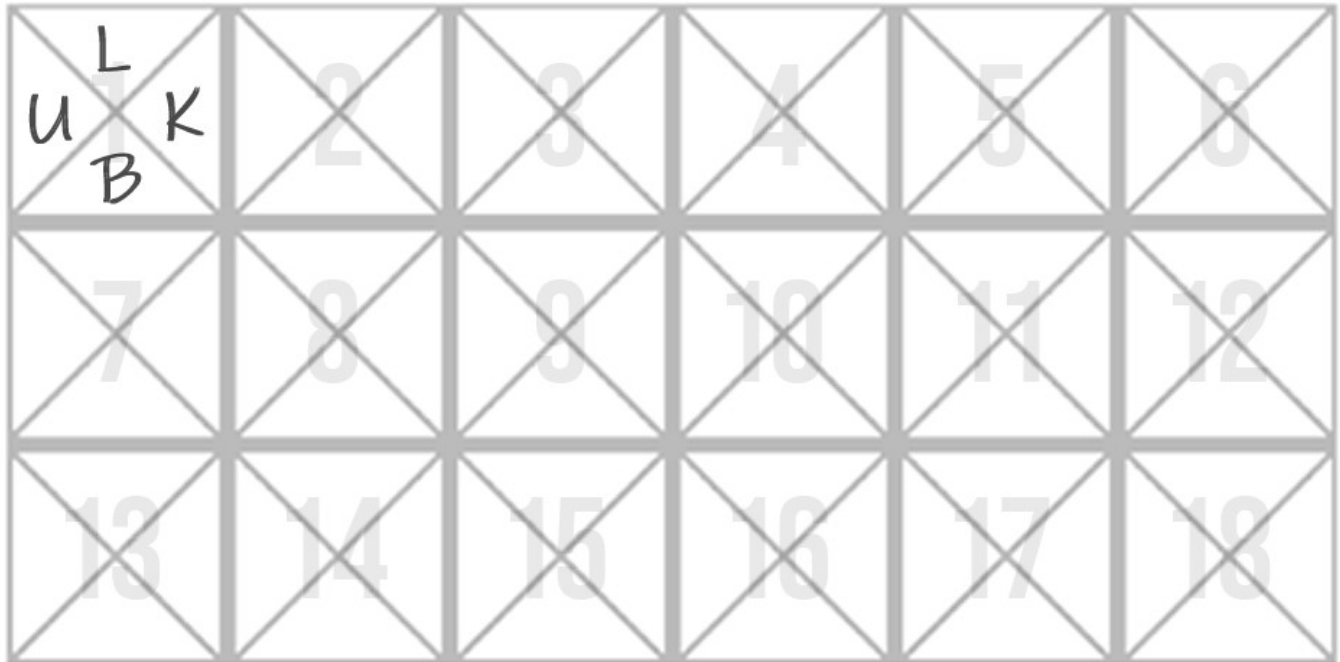
GO FACT YOURSELF – 2025ish Listener Tournament Puzzle!

There are 18 squares in the below grid, divided into four triangles each. Fill each square with the four-letter answer to its numbered clue. The answer can start in any of the four triangles, but it will always run clockwise. Wherever squares touch, the letters on either side of the *heavy line* will be the same.

(To the right is an example mini-grid. The squares contain the answers Coat, Ramp, Tate and Lear. There is also a final answer, COMPLETE, running clockwise in the outer rim.)



After you correctly fill in all 18 squares of the below grid, all *heavy lines* will have matching letters on either side and there will be a *final clue* about a *Go Fact Yourself* contestant written clockwise around the edges of the grid (starting somewhere on the edge).
